Winemaking Notes

FRUIT 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Bartolucci Vineyard on Dean York

Lane in St. Helena.

VINTAGE The 2021 season started off with very little rain, leading to the 2nd year of

drought conditions in Napa Valley. The vintage will be remembered for low yields with intensely flavored, small-sized berries and a relatively smooth and uneventful harvest season. The resulting wines are

packed full of flavor and promise to age beautifully.

VINEYARD Located at the base of the Mayacamas Range on the west side of St.

Helena, this vineyard has been farmed by the Bartolucci family for three generations. With its well-drained soil and gentle slopes, this

vineyard is perfect for growing Cabernet Sauvignon.

HARVEST September 9- 13, 2021

Brix at Harvest: 25.5

WINEMAKING The wine was pressed after 20 - 28 days on the skins and was aged for

20 months in new French oak barrels. Bottled June 13-14, 2023

1750 cases produced.

Tasting Notes The classic cherry and plum fruit characters that define the Bartolucci Vineyard are ever

present in wines from this vineyard. This richly textured bottling presents the palate with a lovely mélange of floral notes, white pepper, spice box, and plum tart. It finishes with enticing cocoa power tannins, bright cherry and ripe berry flavors. Concentrated and rich, this age worthy wine is quite enjoyable upon release and will easily continue to

be delicious for at least another 10 years.
